

## Materials Needed:

- 5/8" Chips
- Garden Ready soil
- Limestone Course
- Wall Stone (8" chopped is great for this)

## INSTRUCTIONS

*Under 6" height*

- 1** Measure dimensions and dig trench for border stone 3-4" deep and slightly wider than stone
- 2** Add 5/8 chips to trench
- 3** Place chopped stone with 8" side facing out so that about half is exposed above the trench
- 4** Fill gaps in the trench around the stone with chips and lightly compact to hold in place
- 5** Line the bed with an 1.5 of limestone coarse to provide drainage. Fill the remainder with Garden Ready soil.



Disclaimer: This is just one way to create a simple version of this project, and is not the only way to do so. Consider doing your own research, or watching instructional videos for more detailed instructions.

## INSTRUCTIONS

*Over 6" height*

- 1** Dig trench for border stone 3-4" deep and slightly wider than stone
- 2** Add 5/8 chips to trench
- 3** Place 8" chopped stone with the 8" side facing the ground
- 4** Fill gaps in the trench around the stone with chips and lightly compact to hold in place
- 5** Line the bed with an 1.5 of Limestone Coarse for drainage.
- 6** Stack next border stone 1/2" - 1" back
- 7** Fill 3-4" behind wall stones with 5/8" chips for extra stability, compact lightly
- 8** Repeat steps 6 and 7 to desired height. Fill as you go with Garden Ready soil to support 5/8" chips
