

RETAINING WALL

MATERIALS NEEDED:

□ 5/8" Chips
□ Rich Mix soil (or whichever works best for your project)
□ Chopped stone or Keystone retaining wall blocks

INSTRUCTIONS

- Measure out and mark dimensions of wall. (A water hose works well as an easy measuring tape hack)
- Dig trench deep enough to bury half of your block, plus a thin layer of gravel. Make trench slightly wider than your wall block or stone
- 3 Add 5/8 chips to trench
- Bury base blocks halfway deep in trench and surround with 5/8" chips
- 5 Compact chips to stabilize
- 6 Stack next layer of blocks 1/2" 1" back
- 7 Fill 3-4" behind block with 5/8" chips for extra stability, compacting lightly
- Repeat steps 6 and 7 to desired height. Fill as you go with Rich Mix soil to support 5/8" chips
