

DRY CREEK BED

MATERIALS NEEDED:	Landscape fabric
	Decorative rock in multiple sizes

INSTRUCTIONS

- Dig out area for creek bed if you're not using an already cleared area
- 2 Lay down landscape fabric to prevent vegetation growth underneath
- Fill the area about 4" deep with your mid-sized stones (2-4" in size is great. If your area has a lot of water runoff use more angular stones to prevent washout)
- Randomly place larger stones (4-8") for more natural look
- Use small stones to fill in any gaps between larger stones.

 Make sure to cover all of the fabric beneath to prevent deterioration from the sun
